General Rules - Venturer, Rover & Leader Level - 2018

All trucks can be made from the components in the official Scout 18-wheeler kit Purchased from the Scout shop, but don't have to be. (Wheels & Frame)

- 1. 18-wheeler cannot be greater than 9 cm in width, and 11.5 cm in height.
- 2. All trucks must rest entirely behind the starting pin, and the truck may not past the rear of the track, a 48cm long truck will fit behind the starting gate.
- 3. Cabs & Trailers will have a combined maximum weight of 3000g.
- 4. The truck must be able to pass down the track (remember there is a centre lane guide under each truck, make sure the lane guide will not interfere with your truck).
- 5. The most forward part of the truck (Centre) must easily rest on the starting pin (We recommend making the front at least 1cm wide) and no portion of the truck may extend past the starting pin.
- 6. If any part of the truck falls off, or interferes with another truck during the race, the part must be re affixed and that group of trucks re-raced.
- 7. The truck may not cause damage to the track, ie No flames out the back etc. Any questions please contact at email below.
- 8. All other materials used in the completion and decoration of the trucks are open to creativity as long as you follow the specifications outlined within these rules.
- 9. No reference to Drugs or illegal substances will be accepted
- 10. All trucks must have been built within the 2017/2018 Scouting year, or else will run as demonstration only trucks.
- 11. Inspection: each truck must pass inspection by the official inspection committee before it may compete. The inspectors have the right to disqualify those models which do not meet these specifications. (time will be allowed to modify entries to meet specifications before a final ruling is decided)
- 12. Ruling of the judge is final
- 13. All trucks and trailers will be included in the judging for prizes
