Tuesday June 5th: Hike the Red Hill Valley Trail

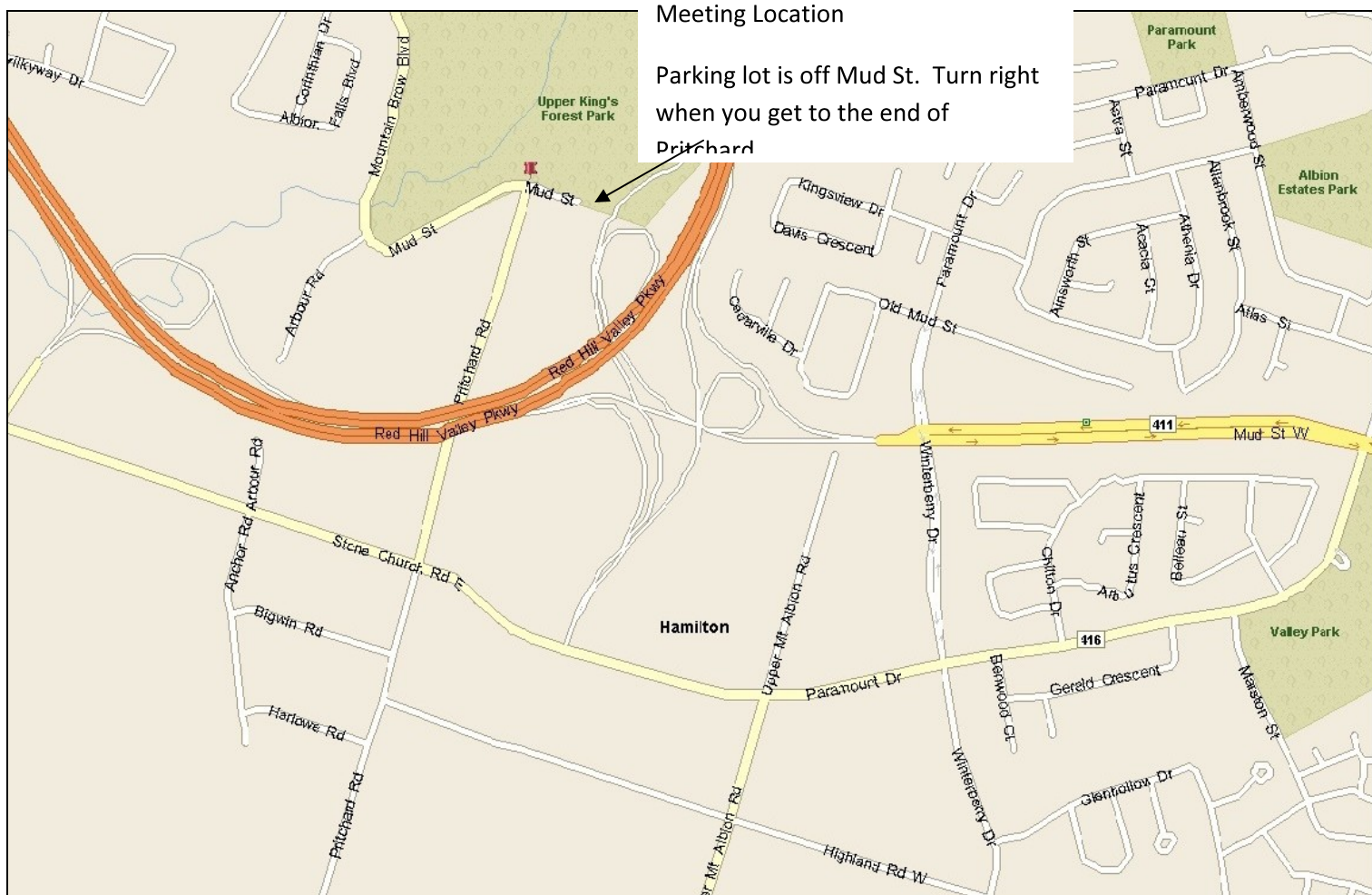
Time: 7pm – 8:30pm

Time: 6:30pm-8:30pm (Please note early start!)

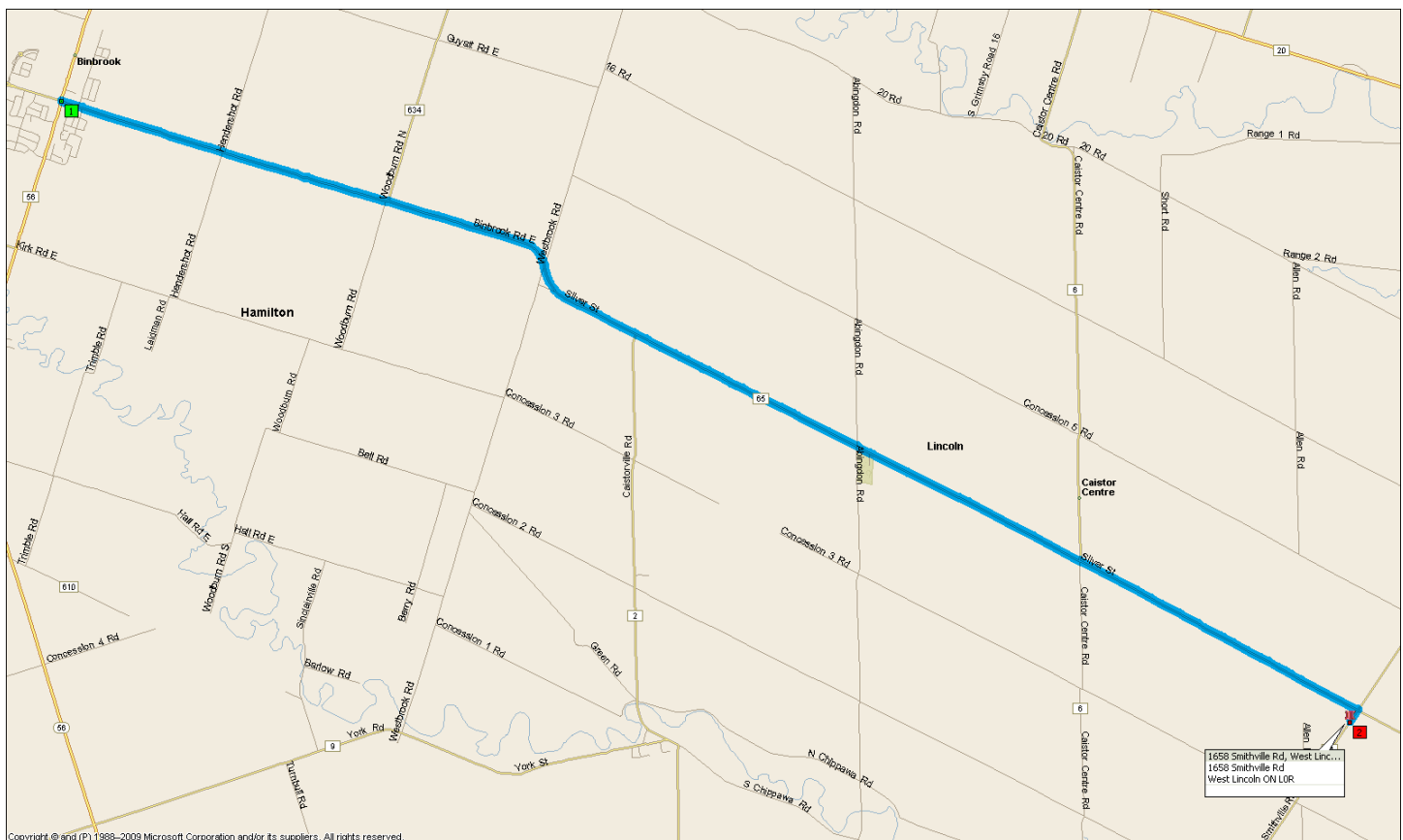
Where: 1658 Regional Road 14 (Smithville Road), Caistor Centre (Chil's House) – see map below

Tuesday June 19th: Disaster Response Night

Time: 6:30pm-8:30pm (Please note Early Start!)

Please wear your full uniform

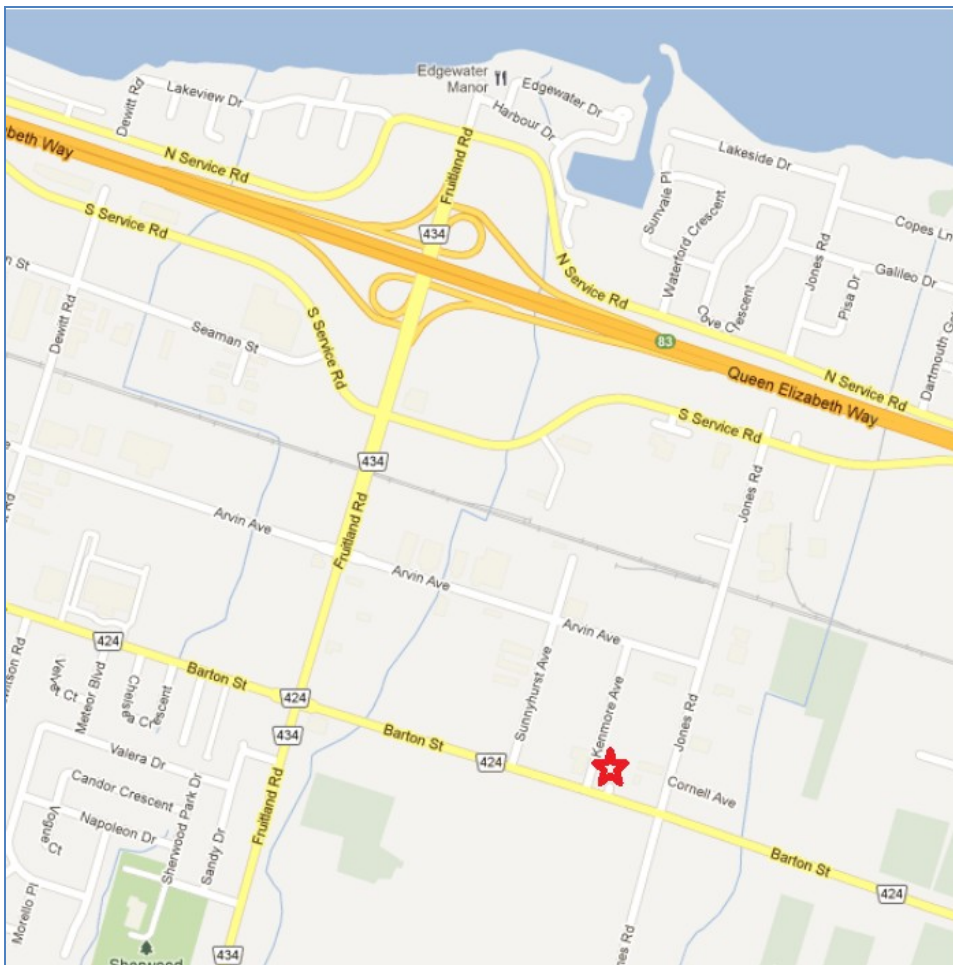
We will be meeting in lower Stoney Creek at the offices of Quantum Murray LP to learn about responding to different types of disasters. Demonstrations and activities on the equipment and skills needed to rescue people and restore the environment following accidents and disasters.

- Confined Space and high angle rescue demonstration (Cubs will do knot work and learn how to package injured people for rescue from confined and elevated areas using specialised equipment) (2 stations)
- Demonstration of a vapour tight response suit used in the most dangerous situation (chemical releases, potential terrorist attacks). Cubs will try on different Personal protective equipment and run an obstacle course. (2 Stations)
- Oil Spill response discussion on the impacts to the environment and wildlife following an oil spill. Cubs will build dams and learn how to recover oil. (2 Stations)

Following the activities, we will tour the offices of Quantum Murray and introduce the cubs to some of the specialized equipment used when responding to different disaster situations.
