

HAMILTON SANTA CLAUS PARADE INFORMATION SHEET

DATE: Saturday November 10th, 2012

TIME: 1:30 PM - 3:30 PM-ish

Parade begins at 2pm

DROP OFF: We will be meeting near Sir John A MacDonald School (map on the back) which is located at the intersections of Bay Street and York Boulevard between 1:30 pm -1:45 pm. The school should be open so that the children can use the washroom before we get on the float if needed. We have been informed that the parade will be approximately 90 minutes in duration. We are entry #55 so our best educated guess is that we will be positioned on Cannon Street somewhere between Bay and Locke. (there are little signs next to each float spot, so you can walk the line until you get to #55)

PICK UP: We are asking that all parents meet us back close to the same area, at 3:30 pm to pick up their youth after they get off the float.

We will have cell phones with us on Saturday. The numbers are 416-428-4200 (Andy) or 905-906-9693 (Pam).

Please keep an eye on the weather for Saturday and dress appropriately. Everyone should have their necker on over top of their coat. If you have a Santa Claus hat or reindeer ears, etc, you are encouraged to wear it.

If you have a campfire blanket they can bring it to wear on the float as well which will help him or her to stay warm.

Please ensure you stress to your youth (Beavers and Cubs) that they will be on a moving vehicle and **MUST** remain seated for the duration of the parade for their own safety. Space on the float is used as is best suited for age, and mobility. (older Cubs and Scouts, may be asked to walk, but it's a good route)


This is the fifth year that 1st Binbrook will be participating in the Santa Claus Parade and we hope that everyone has a wonderful time.
