

# **333<sup>rd</sup> Toronto & 1<sup>st</sup> Binbrook Scouts Haliburton Summer Camp - 2013**

Dear Parents and Scouts:

The 333<sup>rd</sup> Toronto Troop Summer Camp will be held Aug. 3 - 10 at Haliburton Scout Reserve (near Minden). All Scouts who want to go may do so. We will be camping on our own reserved site, Doe island, with adult Scout Leaders in charge.

We leave Toronto at 7:15 AM Saturday August 3<sup>rd</sup>, and return at 4:00 PM Saturday August 10<sup>th</sup>. The fee includes a chartered bus to and from camp. If you wish to drop off at the camp, or pick up after; please advise us. We will be happy to make this arrangement, but it will not change the Camp Fee as the Bus Charter is a Budget item. The bus will load at St. Matthews Anglican church at 3962 Bloor St. West (near Bloor and Shaver).

Scouts should bring a sack lunch for the trip to camp. A meal at a restaurant is included in the Budget for the return (homebound) trip.

Close attention should be paid to the Personal Equipment List on the back of this letter. The regular Personal Fitness form we have on file will be used for medical help in case of accident. Please advise us in a separate note of any new special information or medical requirements that Leaders should know about. Scouts should have their Health Card and Meds with them.

The Camp Fee includes: Campsite Fees, Transport, Food, Crafts, and Activities. It doesn't include: Tuck (Ice Cream, Soft Drinks, etc), Souvenirs, or Fishing Gear/Supplies. We suggest \$15-\$30 pocket money. The cost of the camp reflects increased costs for all of the above.

Cost of the camp: \$380.00 (Cheque payable to: "333<sup>rd</sup> Toronto Scouts").

The 1<sup>st</sup> Binbrook Scout Group is the sponsor of this approved event.

Kindly return the attached Permit and a Cheque by May 11<sup>th</sup>.

We have to charter a bus and start pre-buying food to save money so we need to know your Scout's intentions.

The cheque may be post-dated to July 15<sup>th</sup> if you wish. We encourage all Scouts to raise money for their own Summer Camp.

Call if you have any questions. This is my 36<sup>th</sup> year at Haliburton, and the Group's 67<sup>th</sup> year. Our 333<sup>rd</sup> Rovers were the first campers there, in 1946.

FISHING GEAR (NO GANG HOOKS ON LURES - SINGLE HOOKS ONLY)

BOOKS, Non-ELECTRONIC GAMES FOR A QUIET MOMENT/RAINY DAY

SWIM MASK, FINS

COMPASS (only one)

CAMERA (inexpensive)

RADIOS, IPODS,ETC. ARE PERMITTED. IF THEY DISTURB OTHER CAMPERS OR THE TRANQUILITY OF NATURE THEY WILL BE HELD BY THE LEADERS.
