Upper Mount Albion Road, just South of Highland Road. (you can't miss it)

Note: Upper Mount Albion, is ONLY accessible from Highland now, as they've closed it at Rymal, in front of the new Bishop Ryan Secondary School.

Directions:

From Binbrook, travel north on Hwy 56, past Rymal, and turn left at Highland.

Drive 2km west on highland, and turn left on Upper Mount Albion.

The entrance is on your left. :-)

Parents not required for the hike, but families are of course most welcome to join us.

If you think you might be late, print the attached map, and you can call us from the parking lot. (there are a number of cross-trails as you can see, and we can meet up)
